This steel cutout template is designed for all square size ceiling cutouts of Contraste trims.











MUD-IN-PLATE INSTALLATION

 Unlock the upper part of the captive hooks on the mud-in-plate to release the hooks. Use to the various adjustment holes on each side of the mud-in-plate and adjust the position of the captive hooks according to the thickness of the ceiling.


Note: Captive hooks are preinstalled for 1/2" (13 mm) ceiling thickness. Adjustment possibility up to 1-1/2" (38 mm) ceiling thickness.



Release the captive hook




Captive hook insertion position




Captive hooks adjustment holes


Insert the trim support in the ceiling hole. Make sure the support cable stags accessible. **IMPORTANT:** For square or round mud-in-plate support, make sure to install the captive hooks **(1)** perpendicularly to the wall **(2)**.



3. Lock the captive hooks and make sure they apply a pressure against the ceiling to maintain the mud-in-plate firmly in place.








Captive hook final position

- 4. Plaster and paint the ceiling.
- 5. Pull the housing connector and the support cable out.
